**“ART OUT” at 25th and Mission Streets
 Saturday, June 9, 10 am - 5 pm**

All artists of all perspectives and media -- especially those living in the Mission district -- are invited to an “Art Out,” Saturday, June 9, centered at 25th and Mission Streets in San Francisco. The “Art Out” is part of a neighborhood-wide conversation in which people will begin to discover a shared dream for their neighborhood. Between 10 am and 5 pm, artists will disperse throughout the area around 25th and Mission to create art inspired by the neighborhood, its buildings, people, streets, etc. The neighborhood dialogue will be held on 25th Street, which is being closed to traffic and converted into an enormous café, between 1:30-4:00 pm.

Please RSVP so we will know who is coming, or just come.

A specific request: Graphic artists are sought to paint, draw or otherwise capture the neighborhood dialogue itself (1:30-4 pm). **One or more such works may become an icon for the annual community dialogue.** Participants will be sitting at cafe tables in the street on the block of 25th Street east of Mission which will be closed for the event.

Radio broadcast: Spoken artists or artists practicing art suitable for broadcast over radio will have a chance to be broadcast over **Neighborhood Public Radio (NPR)**, a micro FM station, during the day. **Contact:** Lee Montgomery, lee@undemocratic.us
